I hope this prayer letter finds everyone doing well! We are not bad ourselves. We just finished up a short trip back to Indiana, and I discovered that I am allergic to the state that I grew up in! Every time we go back, I go into coughing fits that last from two weeks to two months. On a good note, I had the privilege of helping a church out in my home town with their teen camp. It was a great week where the kids were detached from their phones, and got plugged into God! They had about 20 kids in attendance, and two of them got saved!! It was great being able to serve them and lead devotions every night. Some of them in my cabin had some questions about the bible, and it was good to address those questions and help them out.

I also was able to go door knocking in my home town a few times. I really enjoyed having the chance to spread the gospel in my home town and invite people to church! Immediately I was reminded that we are no longer in the great northwest, because of the number of homes we would get to share the gospel with. While in the greater Seattle area you may knock on about 30-40 doors in about an hour and a half, while here in southern Indiana you will only knock on about a third to half of that number in the same time. The issue isn't how spread out the houses are, but how many people are willing to engage in conversation with you at their door. At one of those houses where I had stopped, lived a man that was ready to get saved! He didn't know if he was on his way to Heaven, and didn't know that the bible said for sure that you could know that you were a child of God. I opened up my bible and showed him what saith the scriptures, he bowed his head, acknowledged he was a sinner, and got saved!! His name is Hamm, so please remember him in your prayers.

A few weeks ago, while calling every church that has given us a meeting and making sure that they are still getting our prayer letters, quite a few pastors had expressed interest in taking us on for support when they are able! Then we found out that three more churches have taken us on, putting our support about 25%!! We also had our annual conference with our mission board. The preaching was outstanding and the fellowship was sweet! A couple of those that joined with us are on the field, with a couple more scheduled to leave in about a month! Please pray that more churches can take us on for support and we can move on to the next chapter in our lives also!
