Thank you for praying for us, especially for Vaida! Her root canal went well, and has her first crown! It was great being able to have that done for her in my home town. She will get the other crowns as we are able. We have had a good past two months! Our meetings have taken us to Virginia, Texas, Iowa, and Michigan; and our support has gone up to 35%!!

We made a brief stop in-between meetings in Chicago for a couple of days to do some passport work for Vaida. She needed to get hers renewed, and there are only three Lithuanian embassies/consulates in America. We sampled some of the local Lithuanian culture and we felt like we were no longer in the USA! It was great to get to eat real Lithuanian food again, Vaida got to speak Lithuanian, passed out some tracts to Lithuanians, and we also checked out a Lithuanian museum and picked up a Lithuanian history book!! On our way back to the hotel we felt like we were being transported back to the states!

While in Michigan, we had the privilege to be a part of a Mission's Conference with our first pastor! It was great being able to catch back up with pastor Boritzki and see where the Lord has led him. He said that when he told his daughter that we would be presenting at their conference, she said "Wow". Most people don't know what is behind that "wow", but praise the Lord, He has brought us out of all that and is sending us forward for His glory! While there, pastor Boritzki said that I needed to make a CD, so I told him that I had been wanting to for a long time, but the Lord hasn't opened a door to make one yet (while I wasn't really optimistic about it, I had given up on that goal and pushed it aside).
